

April 21, 2010

The governing body met in regular session at 7:30 p.m. on April 21, 2010 in the council room. Mayor Joe Mitchell and councilmembers Galen Niehues, Bob Claas, Ray Shinn, Bruce Hermesch, Steve Bennett and Jim Mitchell were present. Also present were City Administrator Tami Dandliker and Brian Rusche and reporters Robert Wolfgang, Matt Diehl and Jim Copeland.

Galen Niehues noted an error in the April 7, 2010 minutes. It should read "The Golf Club will be responsible for the remaining half of the clubhouse bill, which is \$3680.15." Galen Niehues moved and Ray Shinn seconded a motion to approve the minutes with the correction. All six voted aye.

There were two airport hay bids received. One from Eugene Holthaus in the amount of \$560.00 per year and the other from Bret Jones in the amount of \$525 per year. Bob Claas moved and Bruce Hermesch seconded a motion to approve the airport hay bid from Eugene Holthaus in the amount of \$560.00 per year. All six voted aye.

A request was received from the Meadowlark Extension District - Seneca Office to use the city park for the 2010 Seneca Community Farmers Market. Jim Mitchell moved and Ray Shinn seconded a motion to allow use of the city park for 2010 Seneca Community Farmers Market. All six voted aye.

Brian Rusche presented a proposal for crack sealing for Kraben Drive, Hillcrest Drive and Justianna Street. The council instructed Brian Rusche to check on the cost of a sealing machine or get more than one proposal.

Bruce Hermesch moved and Galen Niehues seconded a motion to approve the appointment of Mary Jane Fleming to the Travel and Tourism Board. All six voted aye.

Ray Shinn moved and Bob Claas seconded a motion to approve Ordinance No. 1303, an ordinance rezoning land (Nemaha County Co Op) located in Nemaha County, KS as C-3 General Commercial District. All six voted aye.

Tami Dandliker informed the council that Bill Claas would be retiring May 29, 2010.

At 7:55, Galen Niehues moved and Ray Shinn seconded a motion to go into executive session for 15 minutes for personnel and appointments. All six voted aye.

Galen Niehues moved and Jim Mitchell seconded a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:10 p.m. All six voted aye.
