The governing body met in regular session at 7:30 p.m., October 21, 2009 in the councilroom. Mayor Joe Mitchell and councilmembers Ray Shinn, Bob Claas, Bruce Hermesch and Jim Mitchell were present. Also present were City Administrator Tami Dandliker, Joe Noble, Myra Noble, Dick Strathman, Elmer Holthaus, Brent Schulte and Harry Leem and reporters Heidi Wolfgang, Matt Diehl and Jim Copeland.

Bruce Hermesch moved and Jim Mitchell seconded a motion to approve the minutes of the October 7, 2009 regular council meeting. All four voted aye.

Dick Strathman was present to request location and lighting of the Vietnam Memorial "Moving Wall" exhibit. Bob Claas moved and Ray Shinn seconded a motion to have the riders contact City Administrator Tami Dandliker concerning assistance required for the exhibit. All four voted aye.

Bruce Hermesch moved and Bob Claas seconded a motion to approve the second amendment to the loan agreement with KDHE for wells 8 & 9 project loan. This amendment decreases our annual debt service from \$120,310.20 to \$76,661.88. All four voted aye.

Ray Shinn moved and Bob Claas seconded a motion to opt out of the cost sharing with the City of Sabetha on the wayside horn system parts package in the amount of \$13,973.01. Three voted aye, while Jim Mitchell voted naye.

Chief of Police Brent Schulte told the council that he is planning to go out for bids for a replacement police car for 2010.

Bob Claas inquired whether american flags could be displayed somewhere along Highway 36. It was suggested that the park committee check into locations for the flags.

Bruce Hermesch moved and Jim Mitchell seconded a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:58 p.m. All four voted aye.
