

## Seneca Basketball Tournament Rules

1. KSHSAA rules apply unless otherwise stated.
2. There will be two (2) twenty minute halves with running clock until last 2 minutes of each half, unless a team has a 15 point lead, in which case the clock will continue to run. The clock will stop for timeouts and injuries.
3. Teams will be given four time outs per game.
4. Overtime will be two minutes in length, with one time out. No time outs will carry over from regulation play. If there is still a tie following the first overtime we will go to a free-throw shoot-out. The 10 players on the court at the end of the first overtime will each shoot a free-throw, beginning with the visiting team, and then alternating shots.
5. A team may only full court press in the last 5 minutes of the second half. Only the team that is behind is allowed to press.
6. The team listed first will be the home team. If possible, please bring two sets of tops in case of color conflicts. Home team should use the bench to the right of the score keepers table as you face the floor.
7. Teams not having a full five player roster at scheduled game time will forfeit the game.
8. Intermediate size ball will be used.
9. There may be a four minute warm-up before the game with a three minute half-time. Any and all warm-ups will be for team members only.
10. Tie-breakers will be: A) record in pool B) head to head competition C) Least defensive points allowed for 3 way tie, if still 3 way tie there will be a coin toss. **Coin toss** – Coaches from the 3 teams will flip coins, the odd coach out will be declared the first place team. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> will be decided by the remaining two team's head to head record.
11. The coaching box will be used. Coaches must remain in the box when giving instructions to players. If a technical is called on the coach, the privilege of the box is then lost for the rest of the game. A coach will have to remain seated and quiet for the remainder of the game. A second technical in any other game, will result in expulsion from the tournament.
12. Any player receiving an intentional behavior technical will not be able to play any more in that game. A second intentional technical in any other game, will result in expulsion from the tournament.
13. Each team will be asked to provide either a book-keeper or clock person for each game. Please report in at least 5 minutes before scheduled game time.
14. Medals will be given for first, second, and third place in each division.

Please have your team ready to start play at least ½ hour prior to the scheduled start of your next game. We will schedule games on the hour; please check with tournament workers to see how close we are to being on schedule. We will run ahead of schedule when possible.
